by these presents, that whereas on the
 28th day of April 1873 one S. Reily executed a deed to
 A. Groesbeck et al Trustees for 81 acres of land in
 the County of Dallas in said State, the same being
 a part of the M. H. Rodine Survey on which the Town of
 Richardson is partly located, which deed is on record
 in Book S. page 630 of Records of Deeds for said
 County of Dallas, and the legal title is now vested in
 the Houston and Texas Central Railway Company,
 and whereas, while said deed was intended to
 convey 81 acres of land, there is a mistake in the
 call for the lengths of the East and West lines by which
 the entire length of the whole town tract containing
 101 acres of which 20 acres is included in a deed
 from J. Wheeler instead of the length of the 81 acres
