is hereby acknowledged, have this day granted, bargained, sold
and released and do by these presents grant, bargain, sell
and release unto the said Houston & Texas Central Railway Company
a strip of one hundred feet in width of land, over and upon which
the said Company has built its Railway, and particularly through
a tract of 320 acres of land in Dallas known as the A.K. Bodine
survey together with all and singular the rights, members, heredit-
aments and appurtenances to the same belonging or in anywise
incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular
the said premises unto the said Houston & Texas Central
Railway Company or its assigns forever
